Sub: Furnishing of charge assumption reports of officers to Railway Board - reg.

While issuing orders from Board for promotion/posting or inter-railway/unit transfer, it is mentioned therein that date of relieving/assumption of charge by the officers may be advised to Board. It is, however, seen that often the relieving/charge assumption reports are not received in Board's Office. In some cases, these reports are sent after a long time, causing administrative difficulties, viz., data maintenance, processing NBR cases of officers who are on deputation etc. Particularly, in NBR cases, non-receipt of charge assumption reports unduly delay processing of cases for issuing NBR orders, as date(s) of assumption of charge of senior and junior officers are invariably required for this purpose.

It is, therefore, desired that all the officers concerned should suitably be advised to send the relieving/charge assumption reports to Board's office as soon as an officer joins either on transfer or on promotion.
