- A. 10% of the proposed vacancies for recruitment in Level-1 (erstwhile Group 'D') of workshops and Signal & Telecom, Electrical Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, Traffic & Commercial Department and Works side of Engineering Department in the Divisions, will be clubbed to recruit equivalent number of Track Maintainer in addition to the intake of Track Maintainer decided for the Engineering Department. The lateral transfer will be undertaken as & when direct recruitment exercise is completed and stipulation of para (A) above have been adhered to.
- B. Trackmen in regular employment in Engineering Department should be laterally transferred to those Departments, whose 10% vacancies have been clubbed and utilized for recruitment of Trackmen. Other Departments will be allowed to induct fresh personnel for the residual 90% of vacancies, and also to the extent of deficiency not met through lateral transfer.

One of the Zonal Railway namely SR had sought clarification on the following points:-

- a) If 02 employees of same category disability are available in the feeder cadre, whether the codre seniority or the seniority amongst PwBDs as stated in Para 4.2 of DoPT OM has to be considered while filling up the point reserved for PwBDs for grant of promotion.
- b) Whether the above provision of Para 4.2 of the OM will be applicable at the time of entry into the particular grade of the codre for counting of the seniority amongst PwBDs or in every subsequent promotion to next higher grades.
- 2. The matter has been examined in consultation with DOP&T. In this regard it is stated that Para 4 2 of O.M. issued by DoPT dated 17.05.2022 clearly provides that:
 - "4.2 An employee who acquires disability, after entering into service, will be entitled to get the benefit of reservation in promotion as a PwBD. However, his seniority among PwBDs will be counted from the date of certification of his/her disability, ie., disability of 40% or more in the categories covered under Section 34(1) of the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016."
