<b><u>MINIMUM EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION</u></b>	<b><u>:-</u></b>	i)	Post Graduate Degree or Diploma in the concerned Speciality from University Recognized by State/ Central Government and Recognized by MCI.
		ii)	Candidates having at least three (03) years experience after MBBS, out of which 01 years Jr. Residency from a Recognized Government Hospital in the concerned speciality can be considered for a <b>period of one year</b> in case of non-availability of suitable candidates as mentioned above in Para-(i).
<b><u>AGE LIMIT AS PER DATE OF ADVERTISEMENT</u></b>	<b><u>:-</u></b>	i)	Upper age limit for appointment is 45 years.
		ii)	Relaxation is 05 years for SC and ST Candidates.
