Sub: Re-engagement of Retired Gazetted Officers who have retired from Jr. Scale Gr. B (L-8, L-9) of Signal & Telecommunication department.

Reference to Railway Board's letter No. 2024/E(GR)I/38/1 (2024/NFR/Officers/Reengagement/001) dated 29.08.2024 & 08.11.2024, applications are invited from interested and willing retired Gazetted officers who have retired from Signal & Telecommunication department in Pay level Gr. B (L-8 & 9) for re-engaged against the vacant post at Gr. B (L-8 & 9) as Consultant against existing vacancies in exigencies of service on monthly remuneration basis. Duties attached with the vacancies presently available for re-engagement as Consultant are provisionally outlined for the departments as per **Annexure** "B".

The terms of reference of the work and terms & conditions is given below and those who fulfill the terms & conditions for re-engagement may apply for re-engagement in the prescribed proforma (Annexure A) latest by 21 days from the date of indicative notification in newspapers, addressed to Deputy Chief Personnel Officer (Gaz.), Eastern Railway, Kolkata.

1. The Terms of Reference (ToR) of the work shall be primarily as under:

- i) The retired officer re-engaged as Consultants shall perform all the jobs related to the post as assigned by the concerned PHOD as provisionally outlined in the Annexure B and may be posted or placed anywhere on Eastern Railway as may be decided by the PHOD and the reengaged officer should be ready to carry out the same.
- ii) The posting and duties of the re-engaged officers are liable to change as per departmental requirement.
- **iii)** Re-engaged officer shall not be in independent charge/head and will not be given the financial and DAR powers and shall not be authorized to issue safety certificate.
- iv) The vacancies earmarked for the re-engagement are provisional.

2.Terms and Conditions:

- 1. General Managers are empowered to re-engage the retired officers.
- 2. Suitability/Competency of the retired officer shall be adjudged, on the basis of last 5 APARs as per established norms for a DPC, before such reengagement by a three member committee of PHODs/CHODs, as appointed by GM. While re-engaging such officers, medical fitness of the appropriate category shall be obtained from the designated authorities as per existing practices.
- 3. Period of engagement shall be initially for one year and further extendable as per administrative requirement. No retired officer should be engaged beyond the validity of the scheme i.e. not beyond 31.12.2026. This scheme of re-engagement of retired Railway officers shall be valid only up to 31.12.2026.
- 4. Maximum age limit of the re-engagement shall be 65 years.
- 5. The engagement of consultant shall not be considered as a case of re-employment.
- 6. Paid leave of absence may be allowed at the rate of 1.5 days for each completed month of service. Accumulation of leave beyond a calendar year will not be allowed nor carried forward in case the engagement is extended. Also, no payment in lieu of unutilized leaves will be paid at the time of discharge/expiry of the contract.
- 7. Re-engaged officer shall not be entitled for HRA, Residential accommodation. However, Transport Allowance for the purpose of commuting between the residence and the place of work shall be allowed not exceeding the rate applicable to the appointee at the time of retirement. The amount so fixed shall remain unchanged during the term of appointment. Retired employees engaged as Consultant may be allowed TA/DA in official tour, if any, as per their entitlement at the time of retirement.
- 8. The designation shall be consultant followed by (trade name) i.e. Officer appointed against the post of ADEN may be designated as Consultant (Engg.).
- 9. Re-engaged officer shall be given the responsibilities like inspections, supervision, drawings, etc.
- 10. Re-engaged officer shall not be made in-charge of the unit like Branch Officer in the Division nor be given independent charge in the Construction unit. Re-engaged officer shall not be given the financial and D&AR powers and shall not be authorized to issue any safety certificate. Re-engagement officer may recommend their suggestion on financial and other matters to regular officer.
- 11. The consultant shall not divulge any information gathered by him/her during the period of assignment related to the organization to anyone who is not authorized to know/have the same. For this purpose the consultant shall sign an agreement of confidentially with the Govt. of India containing a clause on Ethics and integrity.
- 12. Re-engaged officer shall be **discharged immediately** on joining of selected candidate(s) from UPSC or through departmental selection as per the recommendation of PHOD/CHOD concerned.

13. **A fixed Monthly remuneration** shall be admissible, arrived at by deducting the Basic Pension from the pay drawn at the time of retirement. The amount of remuneration so fixed shall remain unchanged for the term of the contract. Annual increment/percentage increase and Dearness Allowance shall **NOT** be allowed during the contract period. [Example for determining remuneration shall be as given in DoE's OM No. F.No.3-25/2020-E.IIIA, dated 09.12.2020].
