ON 5TH JUNE 2025

At Habra Station LC Gate, Team 1 of the 1st Sealdah Group staged a thought-provoking Nukkad Natak, creatively depicting the risks associated with unsafe crossing behavior. The team highlighted safety messages such as avoiding crossing when the barrier is closed, staying alert near tracks, and never using mobile phones or headphones while approaching railway lines. The performance was well-received by commuters and local residents, who praised the group's effort in spreading awareness through such an engaging medium.

Simultaneously, at GCN Station LC Gate, Team 2 of the same group presented another impactful street play focusing on real-life scenarios and common mistakes that often lead to accidents at level crossings. The team used posters, placards, and live interaction to emphasize the importance of following safety general public rules. Their message was simple but clear — safety is everyone's responsibility.

Both campaigns successfully educated the public and emphasized the need for vigilant behavior at railway level crossings. The initiative reflected the Scouts and Guides' commitment to community service and public safety, and it received appreciation from both railway authorities and the GENERAL PUBLIC.


