

**Sub: Indigenous System of Medicine – Homoeopathic/Ayurvedic  
dispensaries – Delegation of powers to General Managers reg.**

The issue of revision of recruitment qualification for engagement of Homoeopathic Doctors for the dispensaries functioning under the aegis of Staff Benefit Fund was raised in the forum of PNM/NFIR.

2. The matter has been examined in detailed in consultation with the Health Directorate of Railway Board and in partial modification of Board's letter No.E(W)89/1-15 dated 03.10.1989, it has been decided that the 5 years experience shall not be a precondition for the BHMS ( Bachelor of Homeopathic Medicine & Surgery) doctors after completion of internship for engagement of full time/part time basis on the Railways. However, the DHMS (Diploma in Homoeopathic Medicine & Surgery) doctor should have at least 1 ½ years' working experience ( the difference in time period between DHMS and BHMS including internship in the latter) for engagement of full time/part time on the Railways.
