Sub: Enhancement in RRB Examination Fees.

In order to partially set off the heavy burden of expenditure incurred on conduct of examinations by Railway Recruitment Boards. In partial modification of instructions referred (1) above, the Railway Board have decided to enhance the examination fees for applying for all Group 'C' posts through RRBs as under.

2. The enhanced examination fee shall be applicable to all Employment Notifications published by RRBs after the issue of these orders.

3. Other provisions for waiving off examination fees for candidates belonging to Women, Minorities and Economically Backward Classes contained in Board's letter referred (3) above, will remain unchanged.

Copy of Board's letter No. E(RRB)/2009/25/21 dated 28.10.2009 (RRCB No.05/2009) addressed to the Chairpersons All Railway Recruitment Board's .

Sub: Waiver of Examination fee for women candidates, minority candidates and candidates belonging to economically backward classes.

Ministry of Railways (Railway Board) have decided to waive off the examination fee for candidates belonging to women, minorities and economically backward classes.

2. Minorities will mean Muslims, Christians, Sikhs, Buddhists and Zorastrians (Parsis).
3. Economically backward classes will mean the candidates whose family income is less than RS.50, 000 per annum. The following authorities are authorized to issue income certificates for the purpose of identifying economically backward classes:-
 - (i) District Magistrate or any other Revenue Officer upto the level of Tehsildar.
 - (ii) Sitting Member of Parliament of Lok Sabha for persons of their own constituency.
 - (iii) BPL Card or any other certificate issued by Central Government under a recognized poverty alleviation programme or Izzat MST issued by Railways.
 - (iv) Union Minister may also recommend to Chairman/RRBs for any persons from anywhere in the country.
 - (v) Sitting Member of Parliament of Rajya Sabha for persons of the district in which these MPs normally reside.
4. The income certificate issued by the authorities mentioned in Para- 3 above would have to be on Format-A which is enclosed herewith. This would have to be issued on the letter head of the issuing authority.
5. This order will come into effect from the date of issue of this order in respect of all Employment Notifications to be issued by RRBs thereafter.
6. This issues with the concurrence of the Finance Directorate of the Ministry of Railways.
7. The above provision may be clearly mentioned in the Employment Notifications issued by Railway Recruitment Boards.
