References have been received in Board's office seeking clarifications as to whether extraordinary leave (EOL) without medical certificate is to be taken into account for the purpose of MACP Scheme.

The issue has been examined in consultation with Department of Personnel & Training (DoP&T) and it is clarified that unless the competent authority has specifically decided to exclude the period from counting as regular service, EOL period without Medical grounds duly sanctioned by the competent will also be counted as regular service for the purpose of grant of financial up gradations under MACP Scheme.
