

In supersession of Board's letter No.E(Trg)98(22)/11 dated 31.12.1999, Ministry of Railways have decided to revise the fees to be charged for training of foreign nationals and non-railway organization personnel in Railway Training Institutes including field training on Zonal Railways, RDSO, Production Units etc., both under Aid Programmes and agreements entered by M/s RITES as under:



Besides the above fees, the Institute may levy any other cost such as messing charge, extra curricular charge etc as applicable. Over and above this, Service charges, as applicable, is also to be charged on the total leviable charges.

The above revised rate of fee will be effective from the date of issue of this letter and applicable upto March'2010..
