

Sub: Clarification regarding admissibility of financial upgradation under MACPS to the employees who have refused ad-hoc promotion.

References from various Zonal Railways have been received in Board's office seeking clarification regarding admissibility of financial upgradation under MACPS to the employees who have refused ad-hoc promotion.

The matter has been examined in consultation with DoP&T, the nodal Department of the Government for MACP Scheme and it is clarified that the instruction under ACP/MACP Scheme regarding refusal of promotion is applicable in cases of regular promotions only. Therefore, the employees who have refused ad-hoc promotions are entitled to grant of financial upgradation under MACPS subject to fulfillment of other terms and conditions as contained in Board's letter of even number dated 10-06-2009 (RBE No. 101/2009).
