

Sub: Modified Assured Career Progression Scheme (MACPS) for the
Railway employees – Clarification regarding.

References from various Zonal Railways have been received in Board's office seeking
clarification as to whether placement of Pharmacists in the Grade Pay of Rs. 4200/- in PB – 2 on
completion of 02 years service in the Grade pay of Rs. 2800/- in PB-1 (Entry Grade), is to be taken
into account for the purpose of MACPS or otherwise.

The matter has been examined in consultation with DoP&T, the nodal department of Govt. for
MACP Scheme, it has been clarified that every financial upgradation has to be treated as an
upgradation. Accordingly, the placement of Pharmacists in the Grade Pay of Rs. 4200/- in PB – 2 on
completion of 02 years service in the Grade pay of Rs. 2800/- in PB-1 (Entry Grade) has to be counted
/ treated as one upgradation under the MACP Scheme.
