**Sub: Revision of pension of pre-2006 retired Gr'B' Officers.**

Please refer to your Railway's letter No.E.800/Gaz/Misc./Pre-2006 Pensioners dated 18.03.2011 on the above subject wherein some clarification on revision of pension/family pension of pre-2006 retirees has been sought.

2. It is advised that the position brought out by the Accounts Department of your Railway in their letter dated 19.03.2010 addressed to CPO(Sett)/Gaz., is in order. As per the instructions issued by the DOP&PW, pension/family pension of all pre-2006 retirees, including pre-1996 retirees, is to stepped up to 50%/30% of minimum of Pay Band + Grade Pay corresponding to scale of pay held by the pensioner at the time of his/her retirement, wherever required. For this purpose, the corresponding IVth CPC and Vth CPC scales of pay and VIth CPC Pay Band + Grade Pay have been reiterated by the DOP&PW in Annexure-1 of their O.M. dated 14.10.2008, circulated on the Railways vide this office letter dated 18.11.2008. These instructions provide for stepping up of pension/family pension w.r.t. Pay Band + Grade pay corresponding to the scale of pay held by the employee at the time of his/her retirement and not w.r.t. the post held by him/her. In these instructions, VI CPC Pay Band + Grade Pay corresponding to IVth CPC scale of pay of ₹2000-3500 and Vth CPC scale of pay of ₹6500-10500 is '9300-34800 + Grade Pay of '4200. Accordingly, the pension and family pension calculated at (1) in Annexure-II to Railway's letter under reference taking into account Grade Pay of Rs.4600/ may be reconciled.

3. It is surprising to note that Eastern Railway has sought clarification on this aspect after a lapse of more than two and half years from the date of issue of the instructions dated 18.11.2008. As such, it may be ensured by the Eastern Railway that DOP&PW's instructions dated 14.10.2008 are followed scrupulously in each case and all the pending cases are disposed of at the earliest in accordance with the extant instructions.

4. A compliance report in this respect may be furnished to this office at the earliest.

On introduction of VIth CPC Rules, pension/ family pension of Gr.'B' officers retired prior to 01.01.96 was calculated taking in to account revised Gr.'B' Scale of pay of Rs. 9300 - 34800/- in PB-2, GP-4800/- and sent to associate CAO/Pension for audit & payment.

But the associated Accounts of this Railway did not agree to revise the pension and family pension of the Gr B officers as calculated and returned un audited Copy of which is enclosed as ANNEXTURE - I for perusal please.

In this context following points are mentioned for Board's kind decision please:-

1. Prior to introduction of Vth CPC rule, Railway Board, vide their letter No PC-III/87/CTC-1/6 dated 06.11.1995, had revised the Gr. B scale of pay Rs 2000 - 3500 (in all departments except Accounts) to Rs 2375 - 75- 3050- EB- 100 - 3750/- w.e.f 30.07.1993.

2. Thereafter, Railway Board, vide their letter no. PC-V-97/1/RSRP/1 S.No./ PC-V/1 ( RBE No. 133/97) dated 08.10.97 (S-14) issued Notification as per Annexure A, under Instruction.(1) of the first schedule wherein it has been stated that " the revised scales of pay are applicable for all categories of Railway servants irrespective of their designation strictly on the basis of the existing scales of pay extend those who were covered by S - 14 which is applicable only to Gr ' B' officers of Railways in present scale Rs 2375- 75- 3050-100-3750 and the same was revised to Rs 7500 - 250 - 12000/- w.e.f 01.01.1996 as per recommendation of Vth CPC and again was revised as per recommendation of VIth CPC in PB - 2 Rs 9300 - 34800/- GP Rs 4800/-.
