OFFICE ORDER No. 50 OF 2011

Amendment in Subject List

Consequent upon the introduction of New Pension Scheme (NPS) on Railways and in Board's Office, the issues related to it would be dealt with by following branches as per subjects indicated against them:-

S.No.	Branch	Subjects to be Dealt with (New Subject)
1.	F(E)-III Branch of Finance (Establishment) Directorate	Policy branch for Pension Rules including New Pension Scheme <i>except</i> issues relating to accounting of NPS Funds to the Trustee Bank, operationalisation of NPS, procedural issues relating to NPS and individual cases, F(E)-III would act as a Associate Finance for issues relating to NPS being handled by Establishment and Secretary's branches. However, in cases, where SLP is to be filed in Supreme Court or where the provision contained in pension policy, be it new or old pension scheme, has been challenged or any clarification is to be given in general to all Railways, or Parliament Questions on Pension Rule/Policy (except on Accountal procedure) F(E)-III would assume the primary role and such cases would be dealt with by them.
2.	Accounts-II Branch of Accounts Directorate	Nodal branch for accounting of funds relating to NPS, issues relating to modalities for implementation & operationlisation of NPS, instruction about Trustee Bank, procedural issues relating to NPS etc.
3.	E(G) Branch of Establishment Directorate	All references received from Railways/PUs seeking opinion, clarification on NPS pertaining to individual Non-Gazetted Staff which may include Court Cases also.
4.	E(Rep)-I,II & III Branch of Establishment Directorate.	All Individual/Joint Representation relating to NPS received from serving or retired non-gazetted Railway employees either directly or through MPs/MLAs/VIPs or from Associations/Federations.
5.	E(O)-II Branch of Secretary's Directorate	All Individual/Joint Representation relating to NPS received from serving or retired Gazetted Railway employees either directly or through MPs/MLAs/VIPs or Associations/Federations and references received from Railway/PUs seeking opinion, clarification on NPS pertaining to Gazetted Officers which may include Court Cases also.
6.	ERB-III & V Branch of Secretary's Directorate.	Cases relating to Officers/Staff working in Board's Office, ERB-III (Gazetted & Group'C' staff) and ERB-V(Erstwhile Class-IV staff now Group'C')
