In this connection it is informed that Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports vide their letter Nos. F.15-2/2008/SP.I dt. 19.04.2012 & 24-4/2008-SP.III dt. 30.04.2012 and Order Nos. F.15-2/2008/SP.I dt. 18.04.2012 & F.24-4/2008-SP.III(Vol. II) dt. 30.04.2012; have accorded recognition to the Ball Badminton Federation of India led by Shri Ch. Rajshekhar as President and Shri Y. Raja Rao as General Secretary and Cycling Federation of India led by Shri P.S. Dhindsa as President and Shri Onkar Singh as General Secretary; as National Sports Federations for promotion of Ball Badminton and Cycling sports respectively, in the country.

In view of above it is advised to delete the names of Ball Badminton Federation of India and Cycling Federation from the list of unrecognized National Sports Federations, as mentioned in Board's letter dt. 03.05.2010, referred above.

Indian Railway receives grant to carry out its activities of promoting Games which is a public service and developmental activity. Ministry of Sports & Youth Affairs is the Nodal Ministry in the Govt. of India for recognition of sports and related recognition of Federations is the Ministry of Sports & Youth Affairs. RSPB also grants recognition to only those Federations which have been recognized by the Ministry of Sports and Youth Affairs.


At present, Sport Federation which do not have necessary recognition of the Ministry of Sport: & Youth Affairs are as follows:-

1. Ball Badminton Federation of India
2. Body Building Federation of India
3. Cycling Federation of India

Zonal Railways may kindly ensure that participation of players of India Railways is in the Games and Nationals organized by recognized Sports Federations only. Merit certificates, medal performance of only recognized games shall be counted for recruitments, incentives and for all establishment related issues.

These revised instructions shall be applicable from the date of issue of this letter.
