

Sub: Revision of minimum rates of Wages and Variable Dearness Allowance.

A copy of each Orders No. (i) 1/19(3)/2012-LS.II, (ii) 1/19(5)/2012-LS.II, (iii) No. 1/19(6)/2012-LS.II, and (iv) No.1/19(7)/2012-LS.II dated 14.09.2012 revising the rates of variable dearness allowance for contract worker engaged in (i) Construction or maintenance of roads or in Building operations etc., (ii) loading and unloading operations in Railway Goods Sheds, Parcel Offices of Railways, (iii) Employment of sweeping and cleaning excluding activities prohibited under the Employment of Manual Scavengers and Construction of Dry latrines (Prohibition) Act, 1993 and (iv) employment of watch and ward respectively w.e.f. 01.10.2012 is sent herewith for information, guidance and necessary action.

ORDER

In exercise of the powers conferred by Central Government vide Notification 1285(E), dated 20.05.2009 of the Ministry of Labour and Employment the undersigned, hereby revise the rates of Variable Dearness Allowance on the basis of the average consumer price index number of the preceding period of six months ending on 30/06/2012 reaching. 202.83 from 193.33 (Base: 2001=100) and thereby resulting in an increase of 6.50 points for Industrial Workers as under. This order shall come into force w.e.f. 1.10.2012.

The rates of Variable Dearness Allowance for workers employed in **CONSTRUCTION OR MAINTENANCE OF ROADS, RUNWAYS OR IN BUILDING OPERATIONS INCLUDING LAYING DOWN UNDERGROUND ELECTRIC, WIRELESS, RADIO, TELEVISION, TELEPHONE, TELEGRAPH AND OVERSEAS COMMUNICATION CABLES AND SIMILAR OTHER UNDERGROUND CABLING WORK, ELECTRIC LINES, WATER SUPPLY LINES AND SEWERAGE PIPE LINES** would be as under:-

In exercise of the powers conferred by Central Government vide notification No. S.O. 1284 (E), dated 20.05.2009, of the Ministry of Labour & Employment, the undersigned hereby revise the rates of Variable Dearness Allowance to consumer price index number preceding period of six months ending on 30/06/2012 reaching. 202.83 from 196.33 (Base: 2001=100) and thereby resulting in an increase of 6.50 points for Industrial Workers as under. This order shall come into force w.e.f. 1.10.2012.
