

Sub: Conducting selections for promotion to posts classified as "Selection"-
Awarding marks for seniority.

Ref: Railway Board's letter no. E (NG) I-1998/PM1/17 dated 20.10.1999.

On a reference from AIRF & NFIR as well as pursuant to the issue raised as DC-JCM item no.20/2009, the proposal to award minimum 60% marks to the junior most candidate, after revision of the marks of seniority as per Railway Board's letter no. E(NG)I-2006/PM1/4 dtd.22.03.2006, under the head "seniority", appearing in the selection for promotion to posts classified as "selection", had been under examination of this Ministry.

2. While examining the issue, it is seen that as per Board's letter no. E (NG)I-98/PM1/17 dated 20.10.1999; railways are free to decide minimum marks under this head. The railways can therefore, decide on their own about minimum seniority marks, so that there is no eventuality of short panel.
