

**Sub: Meeting with representatives of Ministry of Railways for
expediting reference to the Commission in the matter of
Disciplinary proceedings.**

Railways are aware, that, in terms of Railway Servants (Discipline & Appeal) Rules, 1968, UPSC is required to be consulted in certain cases. During the course of a meeting between the Ministry of Railways and the UPSC, it was stated by UPSC, that in several cases, the General Examination of the charged officer was not done as provided for in the rules, requiring them to return such cases.

In order to obviate the above and other such situations, Railways are required to ensure that RS (D&A) Rules, 1968, are followed in letter and spirit. This may be ensured by the Railways before referring cases to Board. This will also go a long way in cutting down back reference being made and resultant time loss, in finalisation of Disciplinary and Appeal cases.

Railways are requested to ensure the above.
