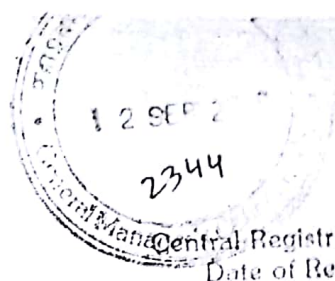

Sub : Unauthorised occupation of Railway accommodation.

As you are aware, there is an acute shortage of Railway accommodation for officers across all Indian Railways. It has come to the notice of Railway Board that a number of houses are under unauthorized occupation, may be because of overstay or non-vacation after the stipulated permissible period for retention. It has also come to the notice of Board that neither eviction process has been initiated in such cases, nor damage rent is being actually recovered from such unauthorized occupants. Such cases would be viewed seriously and responsibility fixed.

It is necessary that immediate action may be taken to recover damage rent from all such occupants as per new rates effective from 01/09/2018 (in terms of Railway Board's letter No.F(X)-99/11/1 dt.14.08.2018) and report on the action taken may be sent to Board by 15/09/2018 positively. The report may be sent to Executive Director/Estt.(G), Railway Board, who would be submitting a consolidated position to CRB.

The type-wise number of such defaulters alongwith the amount so recovered may also be reported in the PCDO to CRB from the month of September, 2018 onwards. It is added in this context that the functionaries of the Railways who are liable to recover the damage rent will be held squarely responsible for any default on this account while the onus for any slackness in intimation of recovery due to the pay bill unit or eviction action will lie with the Railway/unit under whose control the Railway quarter lies.

This issues with the approval of Competent Authority.
