Doctors who satisfy the requisite qualification & age and are willing for the above engagement are requested to report with all certificates for " WALK – IN INTERVIEW".

While attending the interview, the candidates are requested to bring relevant certificates in original with attested copies of the same in support of age, qualification, medical registration, experience ect. and two passport size photograph self attested and application duly filled in as per format given (with one of the two photographs pasted). The candidates should be prepared to stay for one day, if required, at their own expense.

### TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR CMP

**1.NAME OF THE POST :** Contract Medical Practitioner (CMP) on full time engagement.

**2. NATURE OF ENGAGEMENT :**

The engagement is purely on contractual basis for one year or till regularly UPSC selected Doctors (ADMO/DMO/SR.DMO) become available or attains the age of 65 years whichever is earlier. Further the services of these doctors are also terminable before the expiry of one year. The services rendered as contract doctors is a stop gap arrangement and will not have any bearing in respect of consideration of the period in case of regular selection through UPSC. It will also not confer any right for automatic regularization/absorption in any circumstances.

**2(a)** Retired IRMS officers /Retired Government Medical Officers of State Government and Central Government up to the age of 65 years are also eligible to engage themselves as CMPs and for the same, they can also attend this interview for engagement as CMP in Railways against existing regular vacancies . The number of annual terms of engagement of Retired/Government doctors engage as CMP is reviewed from the existing FIVE to SEVEN subject to attaining the age of 65 years whichever is earlier and each term of engagement shall not exceed more than one year as per Railway Board's instruction dated 09.07.2018.

### 3. REMUNERATION

i) Rs.75,000/- per month for GDMO ii) Rs.95,000/- per month for Specialist for 1<sup>st</sup> year and Rs. 1,05,000/- per month from 2<sup>nd</sup> year onwards , iii) Rs.1,15,000 per month for Super Specialist if Govt. accommodation is not provided. Contract Medical Practitioners for whom Railway accommodation is provided with an amount equivalent to the sum of HRA and license fee of the accommodation so provided will be deducted from the monthly remuneration .

ii) Retired railway doctors/State Govt./Central Govt. doctors remuneration as mentioned above subject to the condition that remuneration plus pension shall not be exceed the last pay drawn with the same terms and condition as per board's instruction dated 09.07.2018.

### 4. OTHER FACILITIES

One set of 1<sup>st</sup> class complimentary pass for self & family during each contract which shall be issued after three months of regular contract service (except retired railway doctors).

Contract Medical Practitioners can avail free medical treatment for self only. Other condition apply.


Expenses on out station journey connected with contracted work will be borne by the railway. Daily allowance at specified rates will be admissible for such work.

### 5. QUALIFICATION

MBBS from a recognized University and must have completed rotating internship for one year and should be in possession of a valid Registration Certificate of any of the State Medical Council of India. In Case of specialists they should have P.G. Qualifications/Diploma/Degree in the specialty which is recognized by MCI. In the case of Super specialists ,they should have qualification of super speciality recognized by MCI. Preference will be given to experienced persons in their field of speciality/super speciality.

6. NO. OF POSTS: ( UR- 02) (one post of Orthopaedic Specialist, if not available GDMO may be accepted and one post for GDMO only).

7. AGE : (a)Not exceeding 53 years as on 01.01.2019 (b) Not exceeding 65 years for retired IRMS Officer /retired Govt. Medical Officers of State Govt. and Central Govt. subject to maximum seven terms of one year each.
