Age limit: Thirty three (33) years for those having Post Graduate qualification, thirty five (35) years for post Doctoral Degree holders as on the date of advertisement. Age relaxation of five (5) years for SC/ST candidates.

<u>MINIMUM EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION</u>	:-	<p>i) Post Graduate Degree or Diploma in the concerned Speciality from University Recognized by State/ Central Government and Recognized by MCI.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">or</p> <p>ii) Candidates having at least three (03) years experience after MBBS, out of which 01 years Jr. Residency from a Government Hospital in the concerned speciality can be considered in case of non-availability of suitable candidates as mentioned in Para-(i).</p>
<u>AGE LIMIT AS PER DATE OF ADVERTISEMENT</u>	:	<p>i) 33 years for those having Post Graduate qualification.</p> <p>ii) 35 years for Post Doctoral Degree Holders.</p> <p>iii) Relaxation of 05 years for SC and ST Candidates.</p>
<u>EMOLUMENTS TO BE PAID IN 1st YEAR.</u>	:	PB-3 (Rs.15600/- to 39100/- in GP Rs.6600/-) and other allowances as admissible.
