

Copy of Vigilance Officer/A's letter No. G.157/2021/03/00209/P/V2/N/HQ dated 26.03.2021 addressed to PCPO.

Sub: Inordinate delay in recording of entries of punishment
in Service Records of delinquent officials.

In a Preventive Check done by the Vigilance Department of Eastern Railway recently, it was observed that there was an inordinate delay of two years (approximately) between the dates of imposition of punishment by the concerned DA and the corresponding entry in the Service Record of the delinquent official. Disciplinary action has been recommended against the concerned defaulting staff.

Apart from being highly irregular, such delays may also occur due to connivance of the staff who may deliberately omit such punishment entries.

Further, this undue delay may reinforce a conclusion as to the presence of vigilance angle in a case.
