Attention is invited to this office letters No. CPO/SC/SA/POL/Pt.X dated 03.8.2018 and No. CPO/SC/SA/POL/Pt.XI dated 13.8.2020. in connection with the subject matter vide which criteria for appointment in Group-C Ministerial category on compassionate grounds were communicated.

In view of the difficulties experienced by the Divisions/Workshops in getting suitable candidates in Ministerial categories (Office Clerk/Accounts Clerk), the policy of appointments on compassionate grounds has been reviewed and stands modified with approval of the Competent Authority (GM), as follows:

1. For Widows / Widowers:-

- (a) Post Graduates - Senior Clerks
- (b) Graduates - Jr. Clerks
- (c) Securing minimum pass marks i.e. 40% in written suitability test for CGA.

2. For Wards (Sons / Daughters):-

- (a) Post Graduates (with 50% & above marks in degree) - Senior Clerks.
- (b) Graduate (with 50% & above marks in degree) - Jr. Clerks
- (c) Securing at least 50% marks in the written suitability test for CGA.

The eligible proposals duly certified and recommended by the DRMs/CWMs may be forwarded for GM's consideration and approval and if approved, will be processed for appointment as per all terms and conditions including typing test within 2 years from the date of appointment, etc.

Past cases already decided need not be re-opened.
