**Sub: Transfer on Mutual Exchange - Clarification regarding
'Corresponding Cadre' - reg.**

In terms of extant instructions contained in RBE No. 08/2019 circulated under this office serial no. 18/2019, transfer on mutual exchange can only be considered if the two employees are belonging to corresponding cadres. Further, Para 4(iii) of the said instructions provides inter-alia that the General Managers of the Zonal Railways themselves or the lower authority to whom power have been delegated may decide whether it is corresponding cadres of the two employees seeking mutual transfer.

2. The issue of delegating such power of GM has been under consideration of this office. With a view to obviate the delay in processing the cases of transfer on mutual exchange, the existing power of GM to decide the corresponding cadres is hereby delegated to respective PHODs/DRMs/CWMs for staff under their control, with the rider that while exercising this delegated powers by PHODs/DRMs/CWMs, following point may be kept in view:

“As per Rule 103(7) of R-I, ‘Cadre’ means the strength or a service or a part of a service sanctioned as a separate unit. As a corollary, Corresponding Cadre may be decided accordingly.”

3. Other terms and conditions regarding transfer on mutual exchange issued from time to time remain unchanged.
