Sub : Policy on agglomeration of Railway Quarters-
delegation of powers thereof.

It has been decided that proposals for agglomeration of Railway Quarters within a unit may henceforth be examined, decided and executed by the respective unit-heads at the unit level. Thus, there will be no necessity to send such proposals to PCPO/ER's office for approval.

However, while considering such proposals for agglomeration of Railway Quarters, it **should invariably** be kept in view that:

- (i) such agglomeration does in no way impede smooth functioning of Railways;
- (ii) Essential employees and employees for whom Railway Quarters are earmarked may be kept outside the arrangement of such agglomeration;
- (iii) arrangement of agglomeration should not have any adverse financial implication on the Railway Administration.

This issues with the approval of PCPO/ER.
