A walk in interview will be held for selection of the Super Specialists for engagement of CTVS Surgeon on case to case basis for adult and pediatric cardiac cases at B.R.Singh Hospital, Eastern Railway, Sealdah on 07.12.2023 at 13.00 hrs

The applications complete in all respect with all the requisite enclosures i.e.

Application is invited with CV and one recent passport size photographs (self signed). All original documents i.e. Madhyamik Admit Card (as age proof), Professional Degree, Certificate of Super specialty, MCI Registration Certificate **along with one set of documents (photocopy)** to be produced.

Eligibility criteria for selection of CTVS Surgeon on case-to-case basis at

B.R.Singh Hospital:

A) Essential criteria

1. Age Limit: 30 yrs to 60 yrs at the time of engagement.
2. Qualification: MCh/DNB (CTVS) or international equivalent recognized by NMC.
3. Must have adequate training either within the country or abroad in centers with high repute.
4. Should be proficient in both in adults and congenital Cardiac surgeries.
5. Should have experience in working at centers with high volume cases (at least 250 cases per year) of CTVS/Vascular Surgeries.
6. Should accept the offer as per Railway Board approved rate.
7. As per initial proposal approved by Railway Board, the Chief Surgeon will bring his team members consisting of -
(a) Chief Surgeon himself (b) Senior Cardiac Anesthetist (one) (c) Junior Cardiac Surgeon (two) (d) Specialized OT Nurses (two).

The minimum criteria for selection of team members should be as follows:

- a) The cardiac Anesthetist must be fully qualified personnel with MD in Anesthesia and at least 4 years of experience in giving Cardiac Anesthesia.
- b) The two other Assistant Cardiac Surgeons must have experience in assisting all forms of Cardiac Surgeries for a period not less than 7 years.
- c) Specialized Cardiac OT Nurses should have working experience in Cardiac OT for at least 3 years. (Supporting documentary evidence must be provided by the Chief Cardiac Surgeon for himself, his Senior Cardiac Anesthetists, his Junior Cardiac Surgeons and also for specialized OT Nurses).
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
B. Desirable criteria

Should be proficient in vascular and Thoracic Surgery, Minimal invasive cardiac surgery.

Validity - The selection will be valid for two years. Thereafter yearly extension based on performance, maximum up to four years, following laid down guidelines.

As per the initial proposal which has been duly approved by Railway Board duties of the case-to-case basis Cardiac Surgeon team will be as follows:

1. Preoperative: Assessment of the cases in consultation with the In-house Cardiologist.
2. Operative: Performing the operation in B.R.Singh Hospital using the hospital's infrastructure and resources.
3. Post-operative; The Post-operative services will be provided by the Cardiac Surgeon team with full responsibility and guiding the In-house doctors to tide over the crucial early post operative phase, as also the early rehabilitation in the late post operative phase till the patient is out of CTVS-ITU to the general ward. The period usually varies to around 08 days.
4. Anyone or more number of the team would take a daily round of the post-operative case.
5. The Chief Cardiac Surgeon should be always available for consultation over telephone and may need to be present any time of the day in case of emergency.
6. During the regular activities in Cardiac OT and CTVS-ITU they must also advise, guide and train the In-house doctors/staffs.
7. The first post discharge follow up will be supervised by the Chief Surgeon or one Office Assistant in the follow up clinic at B.R.Singh Hospital.
